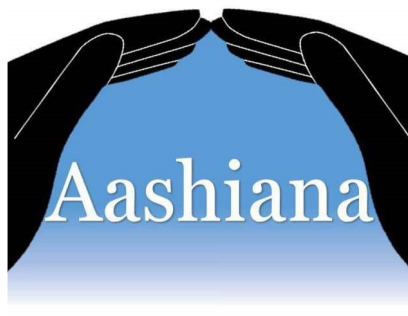


In October and November, we sponsored bhandhara for 800 people in Kurukshetra and Panipat, and also donated and distributed 500 blankets in Vrindavan, India.
